I have tried the left and right connections in both available inputs (it's a Technics stereo and I tried it in the VCR-Ext and VDP-Aux inputs). There is a 3rd wire with the red/white L and R connections but it has no connector on the end just a bare wire.

Can anybody suggest how I can get some decent volume? It almost seems to need some pre-amplifying before it reaches the amp in my stereo.
