We'll need a PT, Hammond 261G6 is what I used for my 5687. ~\$30 Filament supply, 12.6 V TX from RadioShack ~\$13, + caps and LM317 ~\$6 One 5687 and socket. ~\$15 Output coupling caps, \$7 for ASC oilers at Allied. One 6CA4, socket and two 1N4007 for a full bridge, ~\$15. Hammond 30hy/40 mA choke and 2-400 uF 400V cap, ~\$25. Mosfets and heatsinks and resistors for a Pimm-style CCS (output from his 'mu' output), ~\$15. Choke input supply, CCS loads and 5687 amp. for less gain, try 12B4's. Looks like ~\$140 by the time you get everything. It will kick some serious can, I guarantee (with Justin Wilson cadence)! regards, Douglas!
