Thanks Wayne. That tube is most likely what Valve Art sells @ \$39.95. I'm presently using Billington Gold, which I've been told are the same tubes only hand-selected for better quality. I know Cetrons are \$400~\$500ea. Good NOS RCA's are typically over \$300 and you can get a pair of KR Audio's for \$550. I'm most likely going to try the new 845B made in China. It's supposedly modeled after the old Amperex 845 and quite a bit better sounding than the typical 845 being made today. But a pair costs \$150. I was hoping that someone would have responded about the new 845M (M=Metal Plate) that's supposed to be coming out of the same factory that makes the 845B.
