Both are sponsors of AudioRoundTable.com and both carry high-quality turntables in various price ranges from a few hundred dollars to tens of thousands. So write to them 'cause they're both nice folks and can get you whatever you need, in whatever price range you're comfortable with. Also, I know you said "new" but if the budget is really tight, I suggest checking the pawn shops for a used Technics direct-drive turntable. Audiophiles these days prefer belt-drives but I've had good luck with the older Technics too.
