Fred, There are a thousand methods. The hardest one I've tried is using cue sheets -- EAC creates them, but it's not easy to manipulate fora compilation. The easiest I've found is a not free, but not expensive program called CDRWin. If you've ripped your music to individual wave files, you can select a list of .wavs and it will write them. It's always written high quality CDRs for me. If you haven't gotten something going yet, I can review my process and give a more precised escription.Skip
