My conclusion is that uniformity is more important than directionality, but uniformity includes things outside the loudspeaker. It includes placement, orientation and directionality and involves the way the speaker(s) fill the environment with sound. Hopefully, others will chime in because I think there is some real merit in looking at this.
