Some strings are drones, while other strings go through a box with buttons in a standard keyboard pattern. The buttons push against the melody, or chanter, string(s), which shorten them and raises the pitch. These instruments sound like a small bagpipe with violin-like tone, with some small rattling mechanical noises also. Very medieval tone!Dave :^) Hurdy-gurdy info
