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I sincerely appreciate all your help in looking at this for me. I was trying to use some front chamber volume to smooth the response, so the 250CC was based on a guess that the average cone height is 1cm. For an Sd of 141cm I was approximating the "free" (as in I can't do anything about it except a phase plug) chamber volume at 150cc. I then added another 100cc based on a 1/4" (.75 cm) spacer. What I didn't understand was your comment "so change it to around ~80cm² for a 6" driver". Wouldn't I still consider the entire cone area as contributing to the front chamber volume rather than just the area projected under the throat? Thanks again. Charlie
