Peerless has 10" and 12" passive radiators but there is no 8.5" (12"/(sqrt(2))=8.5") passive radiator availible from them so it's not possible to get a 2:1 area ratio. (that's why I said 3 passive radiators)Some things are unclear for me:1. Should the big passive radiator be of the same size as the speaker?2. Did you build the passive radiators yourself?3. How did you build the lever? 4. Which speakers/passive radiators/components did you use to build the subwoofer? Thank you for taking the time to answer my questions.
