Hi John, Happy New year to you! I think if you are using tube amps, then these perform differently enough that one should specify what they were voiced. I believe most solid state amps are soundless, and hence it doesn't really matter what you "voice them with". The Brook was a push pull 2a3 if I remember. The one I use is a SE 2a3 amp. I don't believe overall amps add too much of a sonic signature, as long as they are well executed. But they are fun hardware to play with! and sometimes good tube amps add pleasant distortions! I have a lot of tube amps and love them. They do somehow make the music sound more involving than solid state. probably by blunting out harshness. -akhilesh
