The product has to be packed far better than if it were a big-box item, because it gets shipped all alone, rather than on a skip with two hundred others, and thus hoisted by a crane or forklift by the skip. I'm now packing in a bigger box, with the foam blocks all the way around, and putting plastic drywall cornerbead in all the corners, so the foam won't collapse when (I did not say if!) it gets thrown on a table edge on a corner.
