The SPL on the affordable ones is not too effective but there may be a SPL boost in an enclosure? I do not have so much knowledge about these things. I have only built some bassreflex enclosures and some crossover upgrading before. This Jericho plan I will put together (with some help from my father, who is a furniture builder by profession) as close to the original plan as possible. I will not try to upgrade its original volume/length and I use the 19mm MDF as the original. But I will add double sides and back and fill the empty spaces with sand + experimenting with stuffing. I'm not sure if the 19mm front baffle is thick enough? Do you have an opinion on that? Can I double the front too without doing something wrong to the performance? Maybe make the inner plate a bit wider and carve the circle edge. Well, it's really interesting and it's easy to get stoked over the concept of speaker building. Later! Kane

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
