Very excited i hooked it up to the cd player (Atoll cd100) and my poor chinese tube amp (Yarland) and the first thing that hit me was an extreme response on the volume control!!! The sound was extremely transparent and airy. The bass was fast and homogeneous, not too poor as i was afraid of (starting soon on a horn subproject). It is running now at home as i'm writing this (i'm at work) and i'm looking forward to hear if there are any changes due to the break-in. One thing that i didn't like was a bit hard and loud high frequency. It made my ears a bit stressed. This i might have to correct with a filter, later if the break-in doesn't cure it.
