My first fuill range speaker purchase was of the Fostex FE127e. The advice I got was to take the backs ofthe nakamichi cabinets and install the Fostex. Funny thing wasthe Fostex fit like a glove and I ran them that way as computerspeaks for some time. I now have the GM MLTL built for the Fostex. They are still in use and are still my best (andmy most expensive) speaker pair. "The Brick" or the Fostex 'spiral horn' design looks likethe best for compactness and good sound. Way better efficiencytoo on the Fostex line. What I am wondering is: How would one of those Hi-Vi orFostex 3 inchers improve over the Tangband?
