Bill,Been there, done that.The ONLY way to do HTML is to hand code it using a simple HTML editor. I use 1st Page 2000 - HTML Editor. It's free and reasonably easy to figure out. You can buy MS's Front Page for \$125 and create hugely bloated, so-so pages, but in the end you're going to have to do some hand coding.Go down to your local book store and buy "Creating a Web Page with HTML" by Elizabeth Castro. This will get you started. While you are there, buy a copy of her "HTML for the World Wide Web".
