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Great post Bob! Long time no see...hope all is well. My 2 cents:1. If you HAVE to use a single driver, then a back loaded horn may yield you the bass you need, with sufficient SPL. One of those mongo Lowther horns (like a hedlund horn) if properly done, may allow reasonable SPL levels. 2. The solution I use is a lot simpler: Use a sub for the lower frequencies. This takes care of the SPL issue. Overall, Bob, you are right, a single driver non-horn, non-sub solution is great for simple music played at low volumes, but not really that good for high volume/complex music. -akhilesh
