First, do you hear an audible difference??? In not, then the issue of quality is irrelevant!! If you DO hear a difference, then the rest is subjective as you point out. But, if you do NOT hear a difference, you can save a lot of money! (Of course, older people like myself may not hear a difference, while younger people may. This kind of factor along with statistical variation and room environment have to be taken into account in a well-run DBT.) To say that DBT's are "useless," is, welllll, is just silly.
