There's been a lot of interest and work done with a horndesign called the BIB (Bigger Is Better) first built by TerryCain from some plans in Japanese. All of these BIBs use4, 5 and in one case 8 in. drivers but those would be huge. The design is like a Voigt Pipe with an extra fold thatfires out the top instead of the bottom. When placed in a corner, the walls load and essentailly increase the flare of the horn mouth or terminus With the driver specs that you have the gang that'sbuilding the BIB site at:http://www.zillaspeak.com/bib.aspcan give you some dimensions.One design element of that site is it's not real clear on howto move around. Click in the red "how To Build a BIB" to see basic design principles. Click on the speaker logos for alignments andspecs for individual drivers.Have fun.
