A high Q is a substitute for too little amp power/control - bi-amp. 4. Read about Olsher's Basszilla - I've built four versions and the only drawback is too little Xmax on most mid drivers for "movie" levels. (<http://store.hifiauthority.com/olsherkits.html>).
