3-4 inch drivers:Most systems operate at a lower crossover point because of this important consideration: they ARE USING 6-7 INCH MID RANGE SPEAKERS. For off axis performance, and for the ability to adequately handle the frequencies between 1200 and 3000, having a lower crossover is very important.
