Specs on the M-174:.116A, 37.5 ohm, 1.84 HySAM's gives the following as substitutes:Haldorson C5037Merit C2974Stancor C-2325Thordarson 26C43Triad C17XAll have different mounting and may require some sort of bracket.The Hammond 159T 2.5H, 300ma, 43 ohms might work, but you'd need to check the size/mounting.Lastly, did you consider rewinding? Chokes aren't very difficult to wind by hand. Just measure the wire gauge and count the windings as you unwind the old bobbin.- Gary
