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Hi Martin, Thanks for your post. My understanding is that while a tube amp (like a SET) needs speakers like my homebrews, an SS amp with a high damping factor can handle underdamped and overdamped speakers. In other words, there is no need to tailor the damping factor for an SS amp. Please feel free to correct me. BTW, I don't have a resistor in parallel with the speaker in my homebrews. The circuit (C1) is an inductor with a resistor in parallel with the inductor. Also, I have a supertweeter with a 6 db crossover in parallel with the C1-woofer combination. thanx-akhilesh

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
