It's a "primitive" 3-way "Y" cable, the resultant sound can be "big and full", but ground-loops problem I never resolved. I had even the "guitar rack" full of everything and once blowed brand new "Drawmer" compressor...there are some sophisticated ways (signal "splitter"/booster/mixer), but I forgot almost all about it:-)In rarely occcasions when I play the guitar, I use just the "blackface" Deluxe Reverb (in the last 10 years). And yes, I used with good results M.Boogie "Studio" preamp for that "stereo" things - 2 output for two power amps and two guitar boxes.Try and see, the same power outlet for all amps and check for possible AC difference between the "masses" of the amps...

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
