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I feel bad about raining on everyone's parade, but here's my \$.02.From a formula point of view, the 100W amp is only 3db louder whichis barely noticable. That's when running flat out. If you aremic'ing anyway, that really doesn't matter. When you throw aprocessor in front of the thing, I'm convinced you lose a lot ofthe raw dynamics which lessens the differences again. When you areplaying with a band, you can't hear most of that anyway. The onething to consider is that some amps sound best when really cranked. Its easier to live with a cranked 50W'er than a cranked 100W'er. Think stage volume and/or smaller venues. You really need toplay both side by side and see what's really different. Chris
