A roll of edge-banding for \$35 bucks and we're off to build.You have to find a wholesaler that deals with cabinet shops, or, as I did, a cabinet shop that will bring it in for you. Don't bother with lumber yards or home centers.This could be the be-all. Baltic/Roosian/Fiendish Birch has 'footballs' in both sides and needs to be veneered. This is glue up and finish.Let you know how they come out.
