Yeah, we've had that off and on for a few years @ \$25-\$30. It's Chinese, the quality of the grain varies but the construction is first rate. I've used a lot of it. If you really want a good deal, look for the top or bottom piece in the bunk which will always have indentations from the banding. Ask for a \$10 (at least) discount. And if you see delamination on the edges, cut well away from it. That is it's weakness.
