Some types Doug mentioned (E810F, D3a...) and some others (E180F, E280F-simylar to D3a, even EF184) are surprisingly good, see for example "High-Gm driver pentodes test data" report by Pete Millett.And for the trannies - if I remember correctly, they have 800Vct/100mA taps...LCLC or so, and we are close to 310V DC/95mA - I see nice 2A3 monobloc, we'll see...Picture: EL8 Valvo, 6463 Telefunken, D3a Valvo/Siemens, E280F Valvo/Siemens... Too bad, I have just one pair of each kind.
