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Thanks, yes - interesting discussion. Just to add that high R_{out} of our driver gives better damping of our RCL resonant circuit, and we can avoid subsonic resonance with reasonable values of C_i (a few μF). But, low R_{out} driver (gives us better HF response) doesn't provide (external) damping - LF peak. Enlarging C_i is limited measure when we went close to 10 μF territory (cost and size). One of the measures can be "tuning" R parallel with grid choke...Stay tuned...
