The Seth is a simple platform that offers lots of room for eventual improvements. Everyone is most welcome to offer their ideas about how to improve it. "One can either spend a lot of time with support, or a lot of time simplifying. I think the end result of the former results in better amps...:) The end result of the latter is greater profit, so that's a non-issue in this forum."It appears that you obviously miss the original point of the Seth by a mile or two. The main goal was simply to offer a simple PP design, easy to build for the first timer in amp building from scratch. Nothing more. I'm a strong believer that you have to walk before you can run. In my case I think it's much better for a rookie to start simple than to start with something complicated. Feel totally free to think otherwise.
