Haha, little more patience, please I'll try to propose a few variations - I tried CCS (anode and Mu-out) and resistive load with few common triodes these days, and more experiments are in order. I used "AE-Europe" and "Lundahl" trafo/chokes parts mostly - I'll ask AE about package deal (they have it for some projects) - for PT, chokes, probably OPTs, too; and 115V/60Hz + shipping "problem"... Chasis - I use simple 2HE empty rack, 430x290x82mm - strengthened with "partition", chokes and OPTs inside, PT (in its hood) on the top with tubes. Of course, it can be build in larger wooden box with metal top, or so. Stay tuned...
