Hey, welcome to the forum and feel free to present some of your projects, make a suggestions, etc. Yes, we "believe" in pentodes here, too - you mentioned EF86 and "Neumann" on your interesting DIY pages. Friend of mine is in (expensive) constant search for EF86 and EF806S - not just for the mikes, but even "Matchless" guitar amp... German engineering at that time was something... and those pentodes, especially "postroehren" and "SQ", gold-pins types. For example, I found the comparison of the prices of some tube types in Germany (TFK, Valvo, Lorenz, Siemens), about 1955.; in the well regarded "Das grose Roehren-Handbuch" by Ludwig Ratheiser": -ECC81 - 14DM-ECC82, ECC83 - 13 DM-EL34 - 18 DM-EL156 - 21 DM-GZ34 - 12 DM-E180F - 30 DM -C3g - 42 DM
