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hello Damir I tried the led and I like it more than a resistor and 220uf Nichicon Muse capacitor. The thin sound that I write was because the tubes are new. Later the sound became fuller and fuller and to full then the amp was a little dark. The led brings it a little on the back right way the sound gets also very very clean. I like it but other builders may find it too clean. I had 3 to 3.2 volt cathode bias with the 280 ohm resistor and 190v on the anode (c3g) with the red leds I have 3.65 and 210 volt on the anode. Have I used the wrong leds? Can I leave it this way or must I change it? regards
