They have lots of info, and every driver has tech info plus graphs for distortion, frequency response, time response, free air impedance, voice coil inductance, etc. I don't have a specific price sheet in front of me, but I don't think the Beyma's are all that inexpensive. I believe the retail on their upperline woofers (15"-21") ranges anywhere from \$300-\$800. I do know that I can do much better than retail however, which is why I'm considering them.
