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I would hardly nit-pick over a 1 ohm difference in the network. That's just a little over within 5% tolerance which is better than most resistors anyway. It would make no difference at all 17 ohms or 16 ohms. By the way, power handling is increased with parallel resistors but not with series wired ones. You don't get a power handling gain from a series wiring, exactly the same as inductors. Adam
