Hi there, After reading a lot of discussions in the forum i come up with the following: I always want to see things in proportion. 2-way systems mostly miss something in the sound they produce. I think that sub-bass can only be produced with woofer from 15" and larger. then is the logical step that 1 15" woofer, needs a 12" for mid (or 2 8") and 2 15"-es need 2 12"-es. And double 18" needs double 15". The Eminence If are meant for subbass, so if you would cross them above 1k they won't sound good. Do almost all the PI speakers use 2-way with passive crossings? I don't consider passive crossing networks handy for the purpose i use the loudspeakers. A active crossover network is far more better than passive. I also use a compressor/limiter for the wellness of my set. so if you people would really hear something nice, try a active system.
