Hi Wayne, Last question (I hope), back on 06/02/02 you wrote: " What I do in all my enclosures, and what I recommend to those that build their own bass-reflex cabinets, is to put insulation on

nearest the port. And for this purpose, R13 insulation is inexpensive and perfectly suited so that's what I always use." I'm assuming this includes the Pro Series 7 Pi-18's. From doing a search, and from what I remember reading in the past, was that the insulation should be around 2 inches thick. Does this still hold true? It seems everywhere I look, R13 comes in a standard thickness of 3 1/2 inches. Gerry Provenzale
