A good enclosure size for the TAD 1602's is $30" \times 20" \times 14.5"$, using 1" stock and a rectangular port that's $3.1" \times 5.5"$ and 4.4" long. That would look very good with Bill's horns too. You could reduce the width to 17" and increase the depth and/or height a little too, if desired, matching the width of the cabinet to the width of the horn.
