To provide an option to bi-amp your speakers, I would recommend having two sets of inputs and the ability to disconnect the crossover when the bi-amp inputs are used. This can be provided with internal jumpers, a switch on the cabinet, or connectors having normally open interruption capability. But what you want to do is to have the amps connected directly to the speaker motors when you bi-amp, and the passive crossovers should be electrically disconnected from the circuit. One nice way to do this is to have quarter-inch jacks that wire directly to each motor, and when they are used, they interrupt the passive circuit.
