What you can do is use a picture editor to take a known dimension in pixels and use that to determine the unknown. If you knew the woofer diameter it would be easy using the brochure to figure out the height of the lower box. You already have the width and depth. Then you can calculate the volume to see if that makes more sense. Just in case you didn't already think of doing this. Good luck
