Generally you want the baffle to be as flush with the surround of the driver as you can make it to cut down on small relections at the lip of the drivers basket/surround. Personally I wouldn't worry about it, but then again, I'm one who thinks my Theater 4's sound better with them set up with the port on the inside of the cabinets closer to the listening chair than on the outside, closer to the side walls! Hope I didn't confuse the issue!G.
