Why not go straight 20ga single strand silver wire with Teflon jacket? Forty feet of wire will run about \$80. Terminate with your favorite connector and be done with it. Also, keep +/- wires spaced, since air is an almost ideal dielectric. 20ga wire will handle about 1.2A of current. Your 45 running 2 watts into 8 ohms will push about 0.5A, even at 4 ohms the current load is only 0.7A. You have plenty of margin. I think for
