Is this it?Is these rings placed inside the neck, or could I say its like being placed in the voice coil former? If so, then its not a part of the basket, and that would mean the 2225 and 2235 baskets are exactly the same, because the mass ring is placed on the diaphram. So if I buy a 2235 recone kit, it should have these mass loading rings? Or at least have the mass increased in a simlar way? Thanks!Adrian
