Hi Wayne, For fun, I compared the Omega18 against the Selenium 18SW1P18" subwoofer. Both PiAlign and BoxPlot give a ~3.3 cu. ft. boxfor the Omega, which seems pretty small for an 18"er. TheSelenium has similar specs except for Qms. The difference isbetween 5.53 for the Omega and 10.93 for the Selenuim. Vas is12.5 vs. 13.3. The freq. plot for the two show the Omega -3dBaround 58Hz, and the Selenium around 36. Does the difference in the specs make that much difference? Aside from the obviousanswer, why?BTW, the BoxPlot box for the Selenium is 7.75cu ft. With a similarsized box for the Omega, you get a sort-of ESB alignment, with asimilar -3dB point. Any thoughts? Anyone tried this Selenium?Thx, Chris
