Subject: A couple of 12" suggestions...

If you go for Wayne's quite sensible suggestion of using a 12", there's many possibilities - I have two here; Peerless SWR 315 (can be found at Parts Express) will work fine in 3 cu.ft. closed box - Q will be 0.85, resonance ~42Hz & -3dB at ~38Hz. With up to 6dB equalising you will get to ~25Hz, very nice. The Peerless unit has a peak to peak linear excursion of 18mm (~3/4"), sensitivity ~89dB. And, the Peerless driver is affordable! Another option would be the Eminence LAB 12 - good parameters for reflex box of 3 cu.ft. Tuned to 24Hz it should get you to 25Hz

as large as the above Peerless, but the reflex loading will more than make up for that. The LAB 12 isn't quite as sensitive & also more expensive, though. Just a couple of ideas - there's MANY 12" drivers out there that will do a nice job in that box size.
