But maybe one of the 1" compression drivers are a more practical choice. I have heard that the 4590 and the 4592 neodymium should be really awesome. However I haven't personally heard any of them. What i have on shelf is a couple of jbl 2245 and a 8" focal axiom midrange driver which i suspect could be used instead of the jbl 2123 in an audiophile system.cheersandreas
