OK - I'm ready to fire up the soldering iron - well almost. I sharpened my pencil, diagrammed the compensation network based on the 4 Pi schematics Wayne sent me - lots of lines connecting the resistors (series/parallel), and built a 3 dimensional model out of cardboard. I then looked at the URL sent to me with the attached

graphic:<http://www.audioundtable.com/PiSpeakers/messages/13262.html> and modeled this out of cardboard - and they are two different beasts. So, if I duplicate the compensation network based on the picture provided via the URL - I feel like I should be Good to Go. It will be connected to the Eminence PCB. The woofer compensation network looks easier - connect the dummy resistor to the capacitor, and connect the leads in parallel prior to connecting to the woofer.
