Also, I have been researching a new amp for my system. I came across a mod for the Bottlehead Paramour concerning Pi speakers. The guy who posted the info on this mod - ahem - seemed to be using upgraded iron in his 'Mours. I guess it wouldn't matter which transformer I was using. Here's the mod: Output transformer taps: Primary-.625w tap(blue lead) to terminal 25 and Secondary- 8ohm tap(white lead) to terminal 24. Just wondering. It would be easy an easy fix if I didn't like it, huh.
