Aside from dynamic range, the ability to resolve low level details contributes to accuracy. Through my PI's, I was able to hear:- smack of the lip in vocals- rush of air through the singer's nose- sound of turbulence from trumpet solos- the click of the hammer in a piano- sound of a mallet hitting the surface of a tom-drum before the sound explodes. None of this was available from the "generic" speakers I was used to. But with the PI's you get that "live in your room" sound. Gar.
