An 8" midhorn would work pretty well, I imagine. You might scale the horn I've done by 20% and give that a try. Or you could go with a more square aspect ratio like Bill Martinelli and Adrian Mack did on their horns for the Eminence Alpha 6. Since your plan is to use these with seven

cornerhorns. I'd probably keep the mouth area the same, and simply extend the horn back to where it makes a 4" x 4" throat. That will look nice, making the midhorn width equal to the width of the bass bin. And I expect a horn of those dimensions will have very nice response too.
