I think the mention of 57Hz you are referring to was from my earlier reply to you. I mentioned 1/2 wave cancellation from two speakers, and that it would occur at 50Hz if the speakers were placed 12 feet apart and at 56Hz if placed 10 feet apart. This is the case no matter if the speakers are placed in corners or not. Effects from room boundaries are another issue entirely. You can
